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Winter-Themed Cards

How to use these cards

Storytelling

For best results, print in color on durable card stock. Cut squares out. For additional longevity, laminate cards.

Shuffle cards and stack them face-down.

On your turn, draw three cards. Arrange them in whatever order you want. Use the pictures to help you tell a winter-themed story.

Players take turns adding on to their story, using the picture cards to help.

Problem-Solving

Use these picture cards to help your kids find creative solutions to the challenges on the challenge cards. (Challenge cards are available in the [full bundle](#).)

Cut out the challenge cards and shuffle them.

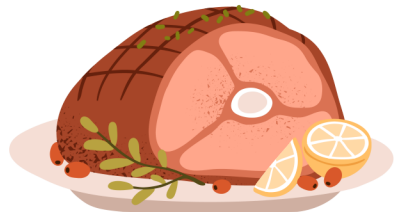
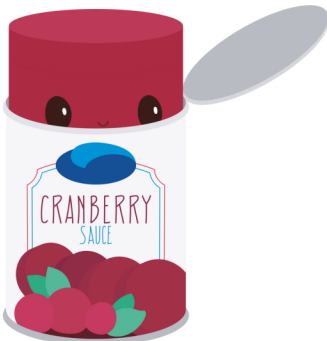
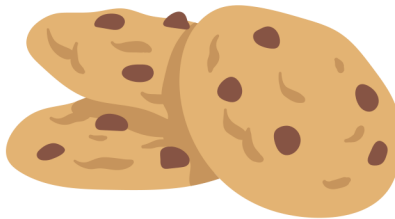
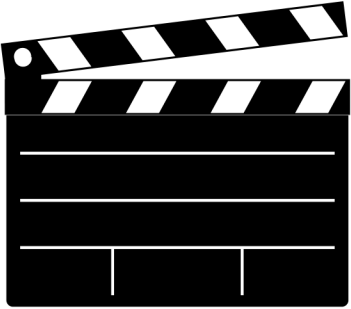
Draw one challenge card. Have a reader (parent, other adult, older sibling, etc) read the card.

Draw three picture cards. Players work together to come up with creative solutions to the challenge. Can't come up with anything? Keep drawing picture cards until you do!

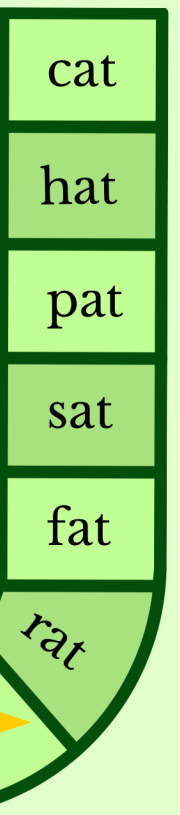
If you have a creative solution without using the picture cards, that's okay, too.

Winter-Themed Cards

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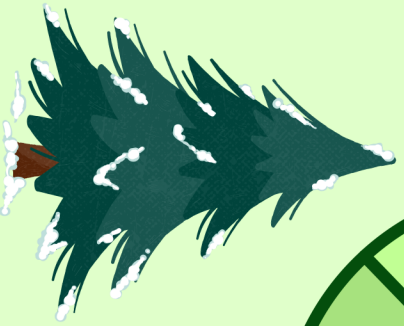

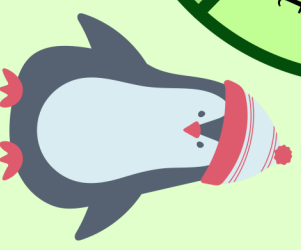
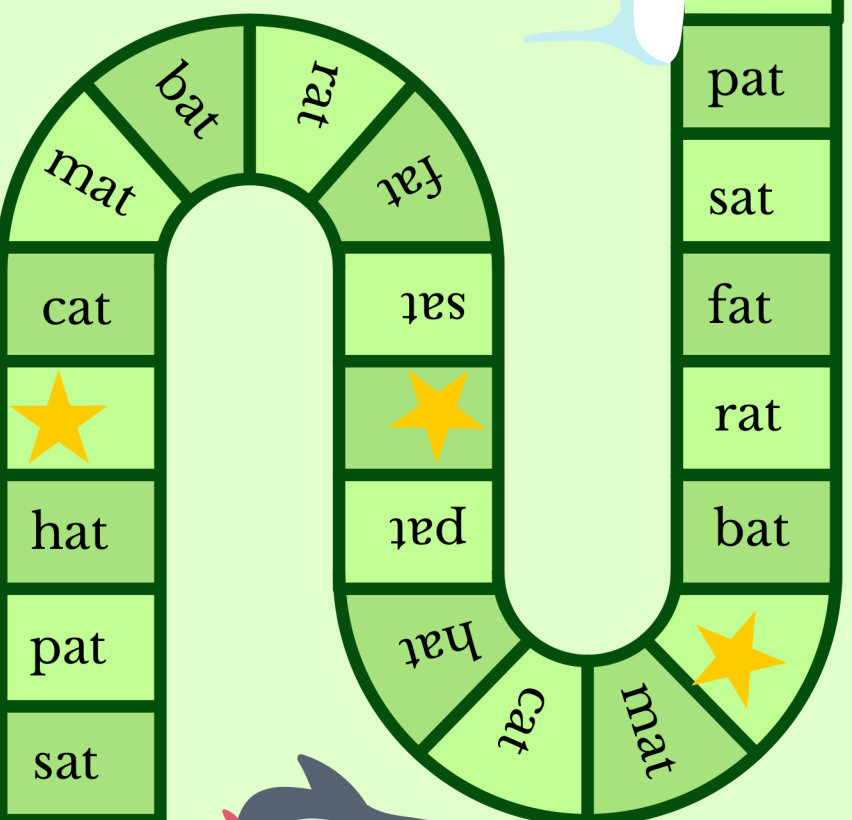
Directions: Players take turns rolling the die to move about the board. When you land on a spot with a word, sound out or read the word to go on.



Use any 6-sided die for rolling.

For player pawns, small toys or LEGO pieces can be used.

Make sure you don't use anything that your child could choke on!

Game Boards

Addition, Subtraction, Letters, and Shapes and Colors

How to play

You will need a regular 6-sided die. If it has pips (dots), it will help your preschooler with counting. If it has numerals, it will help them with number recognition.

Each player needs a marker. Legos or other small toys can be used.

On your turn, roll the die and move your marker the appropriate number of spaces. In order to get to go on your next turn, you first have to correctly identify what you are on.

If you are playing the Addition or Subtraction board, solve the expression you're on before moving again. Make sure you have manipulatives handy.

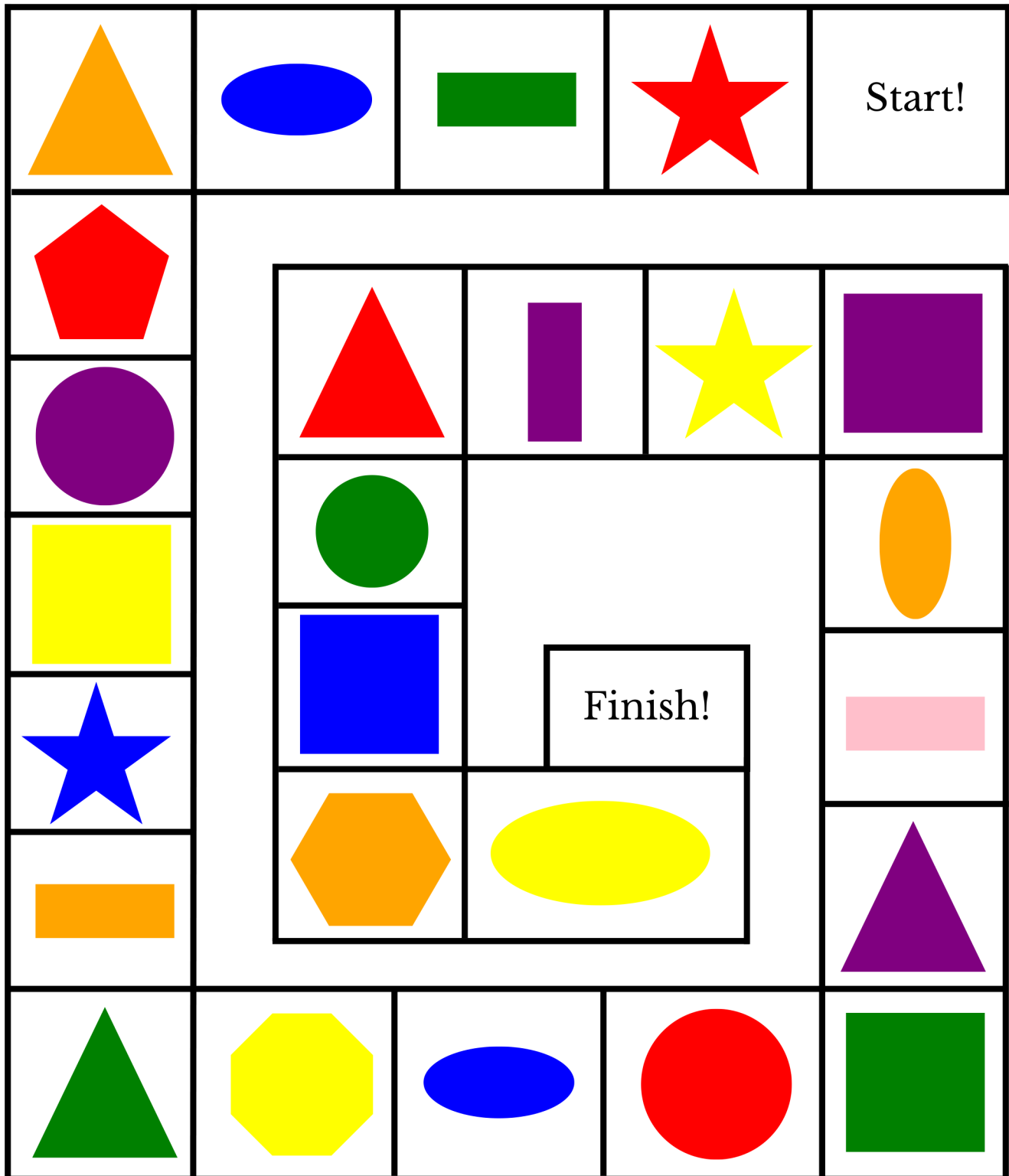
On the Letters board, you can choose whether you are identifying the letters, what sounds they make, or both.

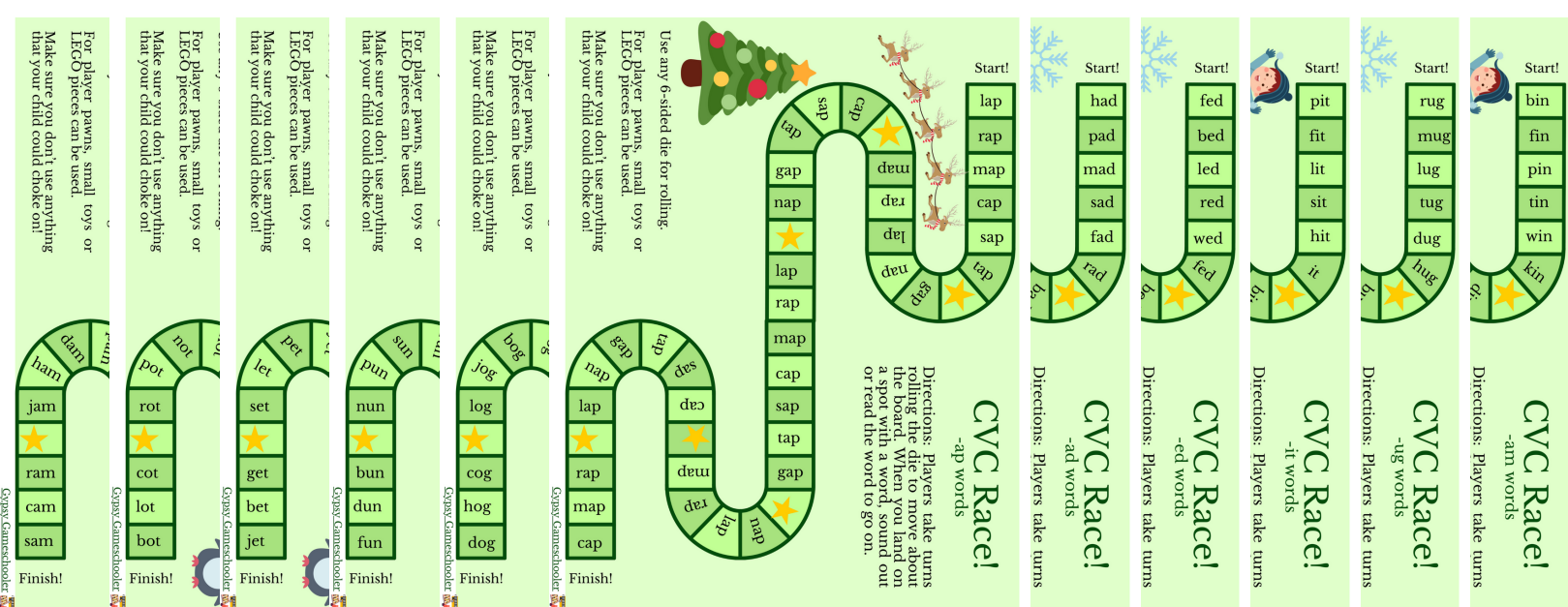
On the Colors and Shapes board, choose whether you want to identify shapes, colors, or both.

What your preschooler is learning

In addition to arithmetic, letters and their sounds, shapes, and colors, your preschooler is also learning how to take turns. Counting the number of spaces they get to move helps them with counting. If you want to work on counting to higher numbers, use a die with more sides.
